We have news of two new initiatives for neurodivergent Children and Young people. The Toolbox from Mindler is a dedicated webpage specifically focussing on ADHD and

Autism support for children and young people. The Toolbox offers inspirational content, self-help tools, interactive livestreams, anonymous text chat service (to ask any questions young people may have about neurodiversity) and lots of other resources and information. It also serves as a guide, signposting users to alternative services and accessible interventions within Hertfordshire. The Toolbox will be hosting a Livestream on 29th May where the team play popular video games and answer all questions related to neurodiversity.

Have a look at thetoolbox.mindler.co.uk Understanding my Autism/ADHD offers a range of workshops aimed at children and young people in Hertfordshire aged 7-16 years with a diagnosis of Autism, ADHD, or both.
