

#### Dear Essendon Families, Welcome back


Welcome back everyone and a very warm welcome to our new families. We have had a lovely start to the new academic year and in Collective Worship we thought

## **RAAC – Collapsing Concrete**

From Simon Newland, Director of Education, Herts County Council. You may well have seen in the news that some schools have been affected by the presence of RAAC in their buildings. RAAC, or Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete, is a lightweight form of concrete which was used in schools and other building construction from the 1950s until the mid-1990s. After some time and in some circumstances this concrete can collapse. I wanted to write to reassure you that this school was constructed at a time when RAAC was not being used in construction and we can therefore be confident that there is no RAAC in this school building.



A huge thank you to the Morton Family for giving so much of their time to the school over the holidays. The Morton Family have weeded, rotavated and dug over the vegetable garden so it is now ready to be used by the School. And they have made a water kitchen for Homewood Class. The children have loved exploring the water kitchen and been having great fun with it this week. Thank you so much to Jo, Shane, Evie and Theo.
