

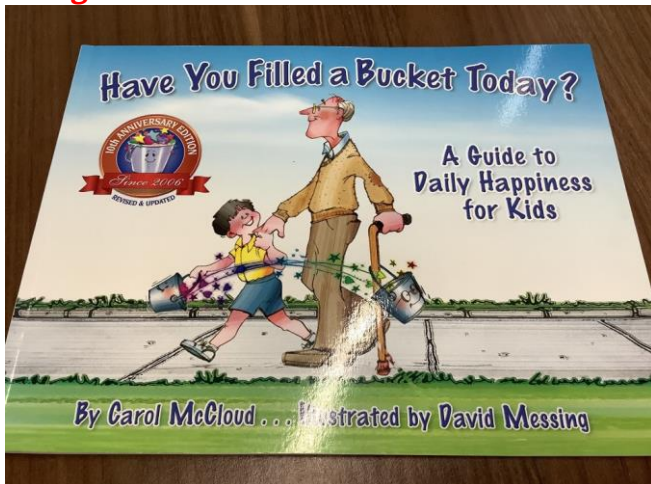

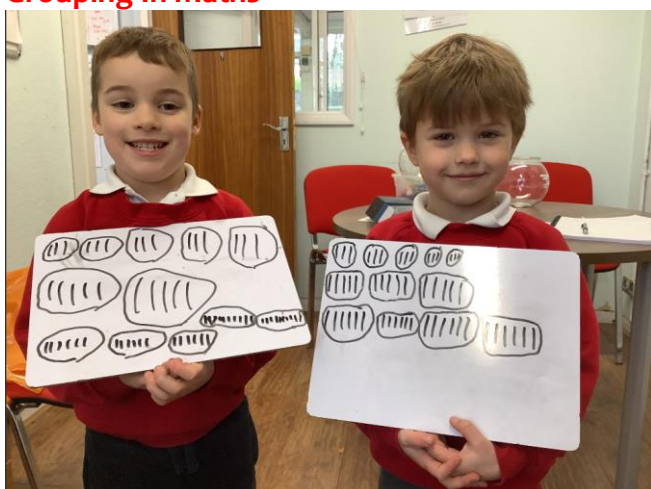
Our Value This Half Term: Love God
