- Reading and writing poetry

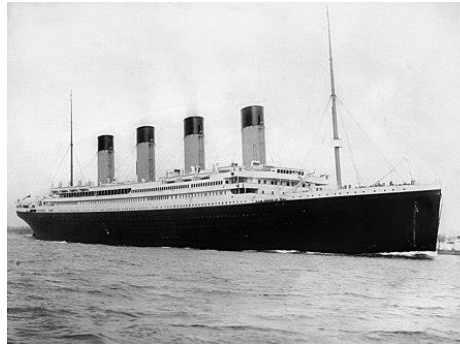


In Science we will be ...
