In **English** children will...

- Write their own story based on the book 'Hermelin'

- Understand how to use fronted adverbials, subordinate clauses, and expanded noun phrases to make their writing more exciting.

In **Maths** we will be ...

- Recognising the place value of digits
- Ordering and comparing numbers
- Rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1,000, 10,00 and 100,000
- Practising addition and subtraction
- Practising formal written methods of multiplication and division
